### New Hartford... a little wild, mighty scenic.

The designated Wild and Scenic section of the Farmington River flows through New Hartford and is considered some of the best trout fishing in New England. It is world-renowned for its trout fishery with brook, brown, and rainbow trout in trophy sizes. The Farmington River is a sure bet to get your heart pumping with tubing over Class 1, 2, and 3 rapids. There's antiquing and classic collectible car shows or, for



those who prefer to hoof it, there's the annual Race Around the Lake or hiking on the Tunxis Trail. Winter offers the Bump & Bust mogul competition and ice fishing on West Hill Pond, as well as ice skating and impromptu ice hockey games on the Pine Meadow green.

◆ Experience the thrill of the Black Diamond trail at our ski resort.



◆ Grab a paddle and canoe or kayak the Farmington River.


◆ Climb a mountain to catch a lofty view of New Hartford.
