F. Superintendent's Report

Thanking all staff (administrative assistants, school nurses and teacher appreciation days) we honored this week and are indebted to the work they do with our children every day. Lots happening with our students between White Memorial, School Play, etc. Superintendent Jeff Sousa presented Declan Murphy and Allie Cravanzola with the Litchfield County Superintendents Award. He also provided the BOE and viewers with the SPED historical budget ranges from the 2017-2018 to 2023-2024 school year (attached and online).

Student performance presentation

Amy Kennedy, Dr. Kelly Carroll & Heather Mathes presented an assessment of where our scores are currently, the historical impact or growth of our students, places where we can improve, and next steps that will be integrated into the 5 year engagement plan. (presentation attached and online)

Superintendent Jeff Sousa said the STAR assessment is something we want to utilize. We will use STAR for our Grade 1-6 Math as well as STAR for Grade 3-6 reading. We will maintain Dibels K-3. New ELA program curriculum based assessments to give our educators real time, in the moment student performance and how we can support them. Illustrative Math assessment calibration will be part of our professional development efforts. Another piece is our progress report alignment, looking at our assessments making sure they line up with our progress reports.

H. New Business

Policy Updates (First Reading by Mary Stempien)

P4113.12, a new policy on Minimum Duty-Free Lunch Periods for Teachers. Compliant with CABE minimum 30 lunch period uninterrupted lunch. We do this now but should be one of our board policies.

Proposed Class Size Policy : The Board agree that unless it experiences serious constraints of budget, instructional time and/or space, school organization, teacher qualifications, and individual student needs the following pupil/teacher ratio guidelines will apply in determining the number of regular classroom teacher

positions: 18:1 for pre-kindergarten; 20:1 for grades K through 2; 25:1 for grades 3 through 6; and for special instruction, State guidelines.

P5144.4(a)Physical Exercise and Discipline of Students An update to remove language crossed out and replaced with writing in red. Superintendent Sousa explained that this is our current practice but needs to be put in our policies.

P5113.2(a), an update to policy on **Student Attendance**, **Excused Absences and Truancy** -Nothing Is changing, we strongly believe students need to come to school. Number 10 has been added to inform parents or caregivers that may be having a hard time getting children to school and providing them resources with information concerning 211 etc.

MOTION by Penny Miller to add Second Grade session discussion to the agenda. Second by Travis Bonhomme.

Karl Hermonat said they only need $\frac{2}{3}$ to vote aye.
