

**New Hartford Board of Education Meeting
Special Board of Education Meeting/Workshop

New Hartford Elementary School**

A. NEW HARTFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (School Tour)

6:02 pm- Tour began at New Hartford Elementary School. Principal Carroll gave the board a tour of the school:

- a. gymnasium
- b. cafeteria
- c. classrooms - RISE and Pre-Kindergarten
- d. Library

Principal Carroll stated that if an additional class was added at New Hartford Elementary, the Interventionists would need to be moved. The RISE program consists of 4 students. Pre-Kindergarten there are eight 4 year olds that attend a full day. The three year old children only attend a morning session.

B. ANTOLINI SCHOOL (School Tour)

Principal Shaw greeted the board at Antolini School. Mr. Edward Mumm ended his tour at New Hartford Elementary School. Board of Education Member Tim Klepps arrived at 6:46 pm.

Principal Shaw gave the board a tour of the school:

- a. cafeteria/gymnasium
- b. art room, selection of classrooms
- c. Oak Hill classrooms

Principal Shaw communicated that there are no additional classrooms at Antolini School. The various Reading and Math Interventionists have their own space.

7:20 pm Board exited Antolini School and headed to Bakerville School

C. BAKERVILLE SCHOOL (School Tour)

Principal Carroll welcomed the board at Bakerville School. She gave the board a tour of the school conveying points as the tour progressed:

- a. cafeteria/gymnasium- pointing out the new acoustical boards on the wall that were recently installed .
- b. Art/Music Room- shared room
- c. Library
- d. various classrooms

Principal Carroll pointed out the new windows installed over the summer. These windows give the students and teacher another egress in the event of an emergency. She commented that a few items on the list of building improvements are painting of the cafeteria and gymnasium and installation of new ceiling tiles in certain areas. There is one empty classroom at Bakerville.
