- *BOF may request First Selectman to publish 733 Form in newspaper (depending on result of actions listed above)

Timeline is compiled based on Governor's Executive Orders – which is subject to change. Should the Governor suspend the orders limiting public gatherings, the Timeline could be changed and the Town could try to re-institute budget vote by referendum.
