<u>Minutes</u>: Open Space Preservation Commission (OSPC), Town of New Hartford, CT Regular Meeting: Monday, 11/28/2016, 6:30 p.m., Sessions Conference Room, Town Hall

Report on ASLA Trails Conference: Rusty and Jean C. reported on a recent American Society of Landscape Architects conference. The discussion focused on data regarding economic, recreational, and ecological benefits to towns resulting from trails projects. John Burdick offered to share relevant data the EDC has gathered. We discussed the importance of commissions cooperating on such projects. Jean C. shared information about porous pavement and lighting.

Municipal Guide to Agriculture and Plan of Conservation and Development Implementation Plan: We discussed our commission's role in protecting agricultural land. There are still questions about the Natural Resources Inventory. Jean C. has spoken with Alison Murdock of the Conservation Commission and plans to do so again.

Caren R. advocated focusing on our current open space project, the Butler Farm. We discussed making a timeline for presenting to the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Board of Finance, and the Town. Jean C. plans to speak with First Selectman Dan Jerram tomorrow (11/29/2016). We are still waiting for the sketch of the map of the potential trail that was discussed at our October 24th meeting. Jean D. will follow up with an e-mail to Dan.
