The Waterfront @ Brodie is open Memorial Day through Labor Day. Normal hours are 10am-8pm or Dusk (whichever is earlier) when Lifeguards are on Duty. WATERFRONT IS INACCESSIBLE AFTER DUSK!

- Access to the Waterfront is Restricted by a Gate. Gates are Locked when NO Lifeguards are on Duty, including Inclement Weather Days & Evening after the Beach Closes. PLAN ACCORDINGLY SO YOUR VEHICLE IS NOT LOCKED IN!
- Use of the waterfront which includes the Beach and all Boat storage areas requires a Beach Pass—this is a use pass, NOT a parking pass. Walk-ins must provide verification of a pass # from their vehicle, wherever it is parked.
- ♦ Applications for a beach pass require valid vehicle registration to confirm license plate and identity of the owner/address of the vehicle.
- Passes must be adhered to the lower right hand (passenger) side of the vehicle windshield. The pass MUST be attached to the corresponding vehicle.
- Beach passes are for HOUSEHOLD family members only. Guests are permitted for a nominal guest fee. The guest must be near a beach pass holder at all times.
- Oroups of 10 or more must register in advance with the waterfront director or the Recreation Office.
- Swimming is **NOT** allowed **WITHOUT** a lifeguard on duty.
- Swimming is permitted in the designated area only. Swimming in either boating areas or out of the roped area is NOT allowed.
- ♦ No hanging or pulling on the buoys or buoy lines.
- Swimming aids and flotation devices are allowed only if certified for safety (i.e. Coast Guard approved, etc.) and only in areas designated by the waterfront staff. No kickboards, noodles or tubes. Please check with Waterfront Director for further information.
- ♦ Snorkeling is **NOT** allowed. Scuba diving is **NOT** permitted @ Brodie Waterfront.
- ◊ Parents/guardians are responsible for the safe play of their children.
- ♦ Children 16 years and under **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.

- Please be respectful of other beach users (i.e. radio use, no sand throwing or rock kicking, no rough play, no vulgar language, etc.)
- ♦ Dogs are **NOT** allowed on beach.
- ♦ Absolutely **No Alcohol** is allowed in the waterfront area including the beach, picnic area and parking lot.
- ♦ Glass bottles or containers are **NOT** allowed on the beach or near the Boat Areas.
- ♦ Fishing is only allowed outside of the swimming area.
- ◊ Grills are provided for use. Please do not bring in your own charcoal grill.
- ♦ The waterfront may be closed during inclement weather.
- ◊ Violations of rules can/will result in sticker revocation.
- Patrons are expected to adhere to the safety instructions of the lifeguard on duty, including but not limited to evacuating the water or waterfront area during times of inclement weather.
- ♦ The Town of New Hartford is not responsible for any injuries, theft or damage to personal property or vehicles while at Brodie Park.
