- 1.) To hold a Public Hearing in accordance with Section 7-163e of the Connecticut General Statutes to discuss the proposed sale of the real property associated with the sale of the water and wastewater assets of the Town of New Hartford to Aquarion Water Company.
- 2.) To consider and act upon the recommendations made by the Board of Finance regarding appropriations to be made utilizing the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds totaling \$984,400.00.
- 3.) To elect a member to the Stanclift Cove Authority; term to expire June 30, 2025.
- 4.) Pursuant to Section 7-7 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revision of 1958, as amended, to adjourn said Annual Town Meeting at its conclusion and to submit Item number 2 on the call of this meeting to be voted upon using voting tabulators on Tuesday, May 3, 2022 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Electors residing in the Voting District #1 shall vote at the New Hartford Town Hall, 530 Main Street in New Hartford. Electors residing in the Voting District #2 shall vote at the South End Fire House, 20 Antolini Road in New Hartford. Voters qualified to vote at town meeting who are not electors shall vote at their respective polling places. Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk, 530 Main Street, New Hartford, CT and will be counted at their respective polling places. The question to be voted upon shall be placed on the ballots as: "Shall the appropriations totaling \$984,400.00 utilizing funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act as recommended by the Board of Finance be accepted?" Voters approving the question will vote "Yes" and those opposing the question will vote "No."
