Full Snow Moon Walk

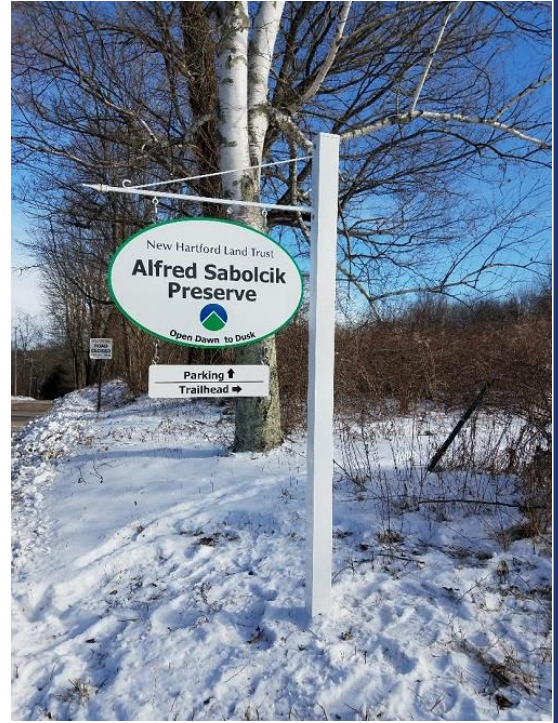

Join us for an evening under the Snow Moon and the stars and some hot cocoa! Details below and at right.

To reach this Preserve in wintertime when the middle section of Sabolcik Road is closed, vehicles must enter from East Cotton Hill Road (the west side). You cannot reach the Preserve by car from the South Road side in winter.



The NHLT's Alfred Sabolcik Preserve is a great spot for snowshoeing or cross-country skiing. It is open dawn to dusk. No dogs please!

Come out for an evening walk/snowshoe/ski under the nearly full Snow Moon and a cup of hot cocoa. If the sky is clear enough, we will see a micro moon, the full moon that is farthest from the earth- though it doesn't look farther away than other full moons to the human eye.

Bring your family and friends! Park and meet at the trailhead. NHLT volunteers will direct you to other parking if full. Please note that no pets are permitted at this property due to grassland bird habitat.

Please RSVP via e-mail to newhartfordlandtrust@yahoo.com, especially if it has just snowed, so we can direct you to plowed parking. The Full Moon Walk will cancel if weather or cloudy conditions hinder our view of the sky.
