Update from Nurses:

- Vision Screening with Lion's Club screened 386 students; Antolini 7 opt out, 10 failed; BAK no opt out, 7 fail; NHES 3 opt out, 11 failure. This is mandated by the State. If a child fails the test, a letter is sent home.
- Scoliosis screening coming up. Hearing testing at NHES and BAK in progress.
- Less absenteeism; more healthy students!

COVID-19 Update:
