Direct access to your boat/kayak is limited to park operating hours; Gates are locked when the beach is closed – you may need to park in the upper lot and walk to your boat. Access is not authorized after dark.

Gates to the lower parking lot are locked at the closing of the beach. Plan accordingly so that your vehicle is not locked in the lot at beach closing. You will not be able to exit if the gates are locked. Keep in mind that inclement weather may result in early closing and gates will be locked accordingly – keep an eye on the sky!

- 1. Reservations for space must be renewed each year. Spaces are limited and are first-come, first serve; there is no guarantee of a space each year. Residents may reserve beginning April 3, 2023; Non-residents April 17, 2023 2. The Town of New Hartford is not responsible for any injuries incurred.
- 3. The Town of New Hartford is not responsible for the theft of/or damage to boats and/or personal property. Be sure to LOCK YOUR BOAT! Any theft, damage, etc. should be reported to New Hartford Police immediately. It is your responsibility to check your boat regularly. Water levels may fluctuate and may affect your moored boat. All boats (including canoes and kayaks) should be checked following periods of inclement weather.
- 4. Boats/Kayaks/Canoes may be stored at Brodie Park in the designated space from April 3 through October 15. Pay attention to the water level at the Lake; the Association begins drawdown in early October.
- 5. Boats/Kayaks/Canoes left after October 15 may be considered unclaimed. Unclaimed canoes/kayaks will be disposed of at the discretion of the Town of New Hartford.
- 6. 2023 Fee Schedule: Mooring fees: ALL BOATS (regardless of size) \$550.00

Please be considerate of how you store your boats/kayaks/canoe – do not make it difficult for others to access their boats. Remove any planks, cinder blocks, etc that you have used to access your boat at the end of the season. Do not leave anything behind when you remove your boat for the season. There is no guarantee of spots each year.
